The HGC Arbitrage Fund LP (the "Fund") is a Merger Arbitrage fund which targets over 70% exposure to definitive deals. The Fund specializes in the North American small and mid-cap market. Other primary objectives of the Fund are short duration (quick portfolio turnover) and high liquidity. The Fund seeks to further returns through actively trading deal spreads both long and short.

The Fund returned +0.80% in June vs. -0.75% for the TSX Total Return.

It was an active month for the fund as a number of deals closed in both the Subscription Receipt and traditional Merger Arbitrage portions of the portfolio.

One of the longer time-framed sub receipt trades closed during the month as Parkland Fuel Corporation (PKI.TSX) completed its purchase of the majority of the Canadian assets of CST Brands from Couche-Tard. Additionally, Capital Power Corporation (CPX.TSX) completed their acquisition of Decatur Power Holdings in June. The company had issued \$183 million worth of sub receipts to partially finance their purchase of Decatur back in April.

On the Merger Arb front, Canadian financial technology provider DH Corp. (formerly Davis + Henderson) was purchased by Texas-based Vista Equity Partners. DH has close to 8,000 customers, including Canada's five biggest lenders and more than half of the world's 50 largest banks. At a total consideration of C\$4.8 billion, this deal was the largest takeover of a Canadian company by a foreign firm since December 2014.
